
Our Busiest Month

In order to improve our service, we have also encouraged clients to check their hampers and to let us know if any item needs changing due to dietary requirements, personal preferences, and/or the availability of cooking facilities reflected in their current housing situation. This has provided some autonomy for personal choice.
